

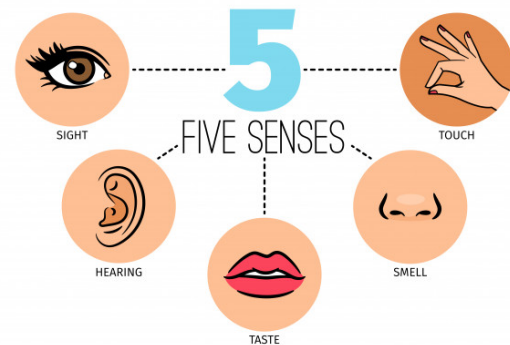
Helping Folks “Catch the Buzz”

The 5 Senses

Make sure you include as many of the senses as you can in your presentation.

Don't assume all students will be able to name all five senses, ask the students to help you list them.

Once you have TASTE, SMELL, TOUCH, HEARING and SIGHT, ask students how they can use these senses to learn more about honeybees.



Bees have complex eyes but no ears. How do they communicate with each other, especially inside a dark beehive? Topics can include vibration, temperature, alarm pheromone, queen pheromone, the waggle dance, response to a smoker, etc.



Bringing an observation hive is one of the best ways to engage all the senses! “Bee” creative!

And of course, you must find a way to offer a taste of honey!
